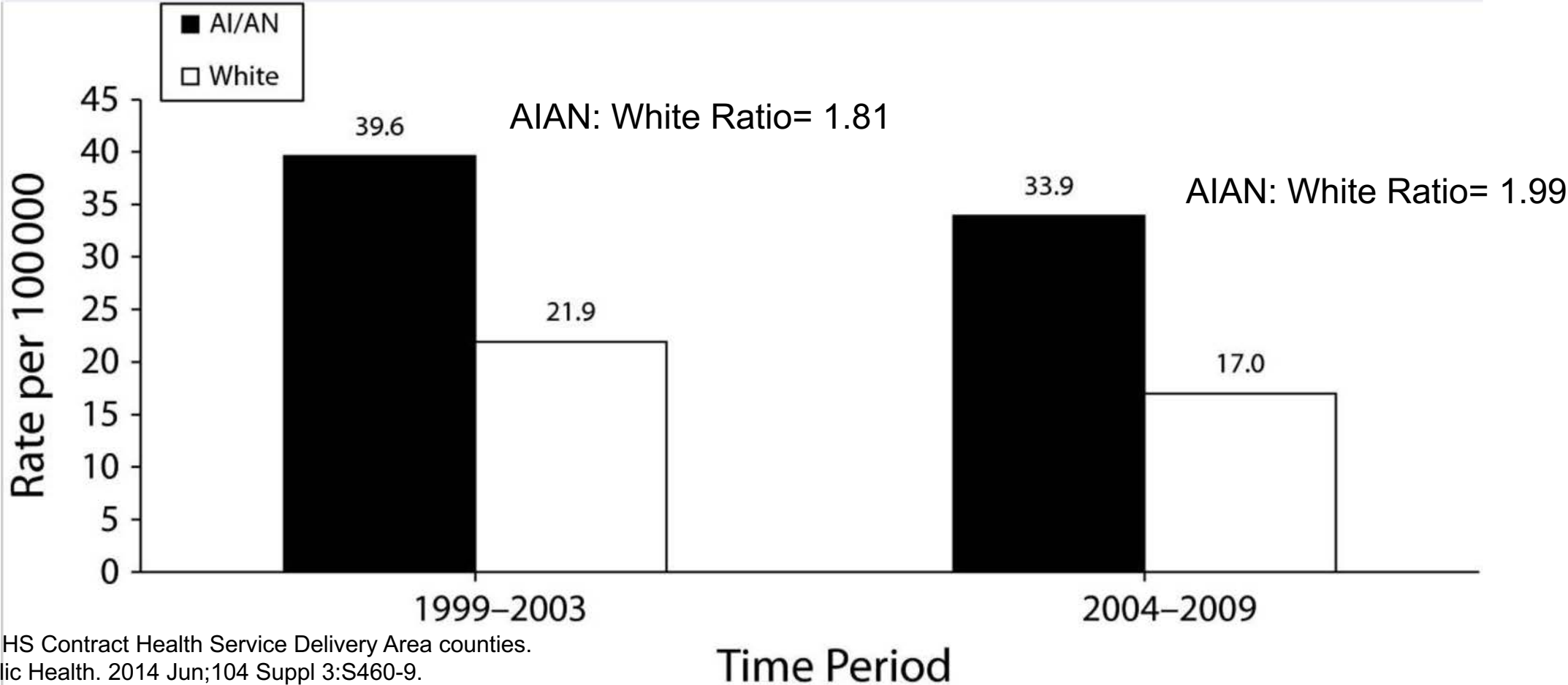


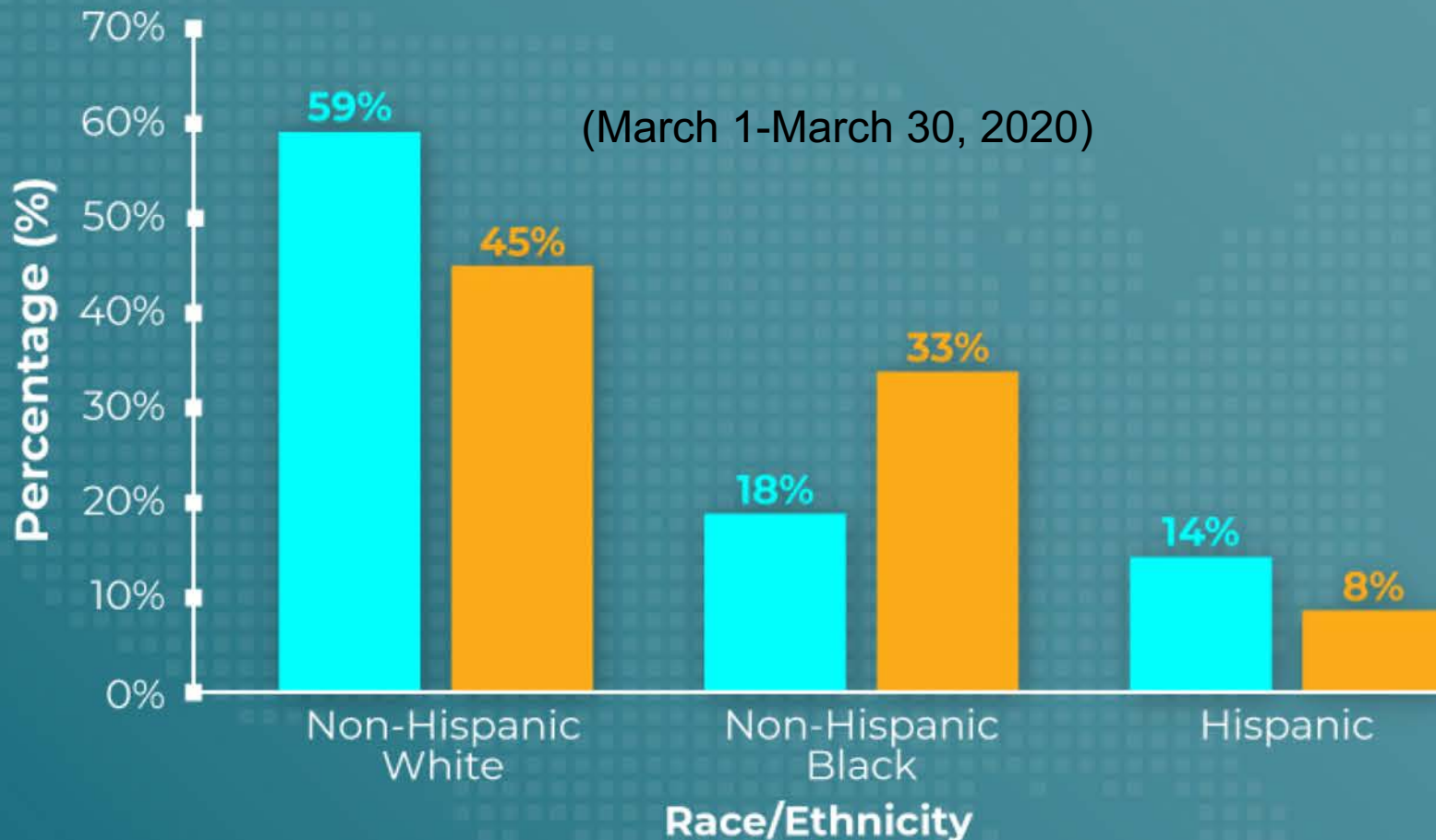

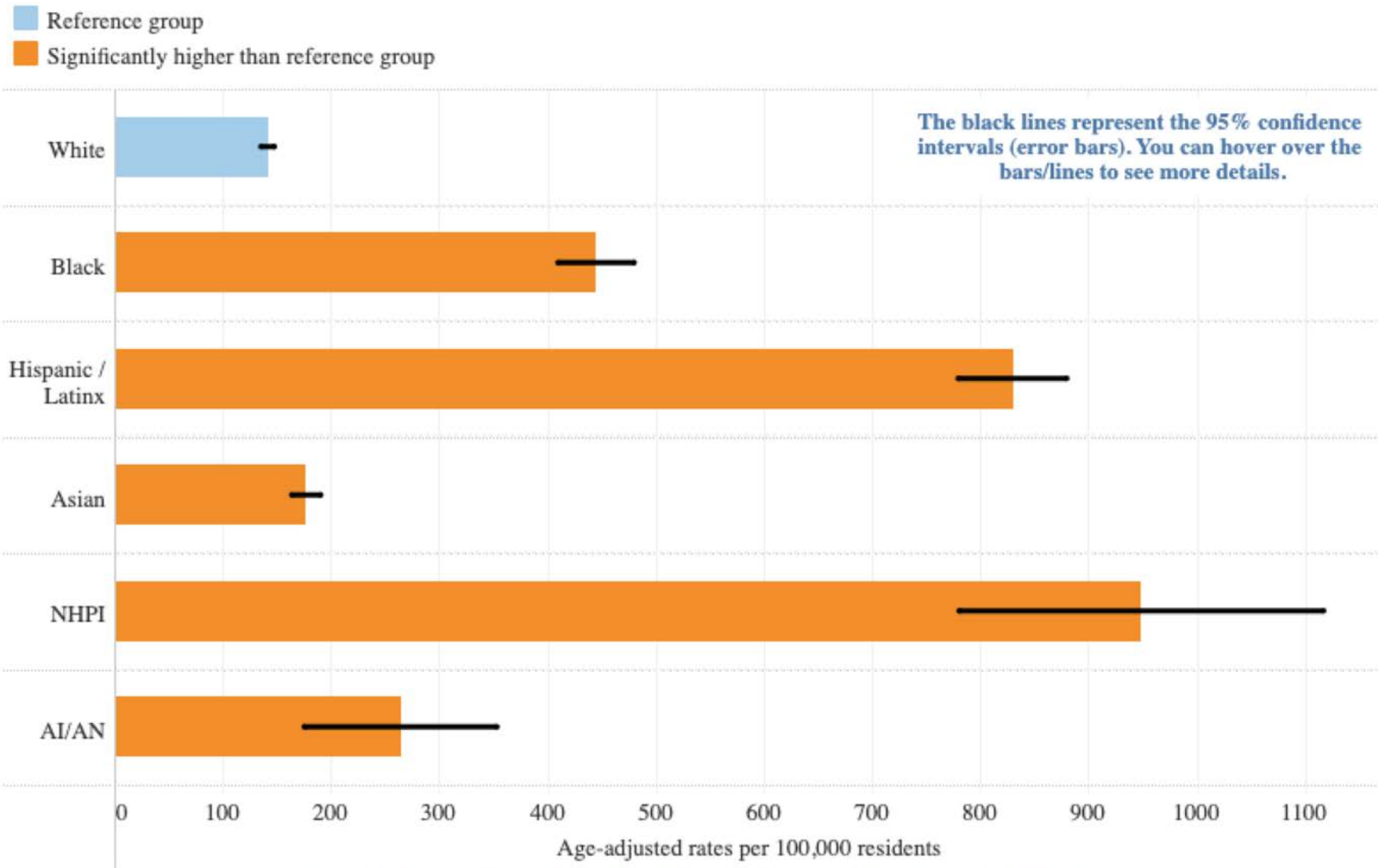

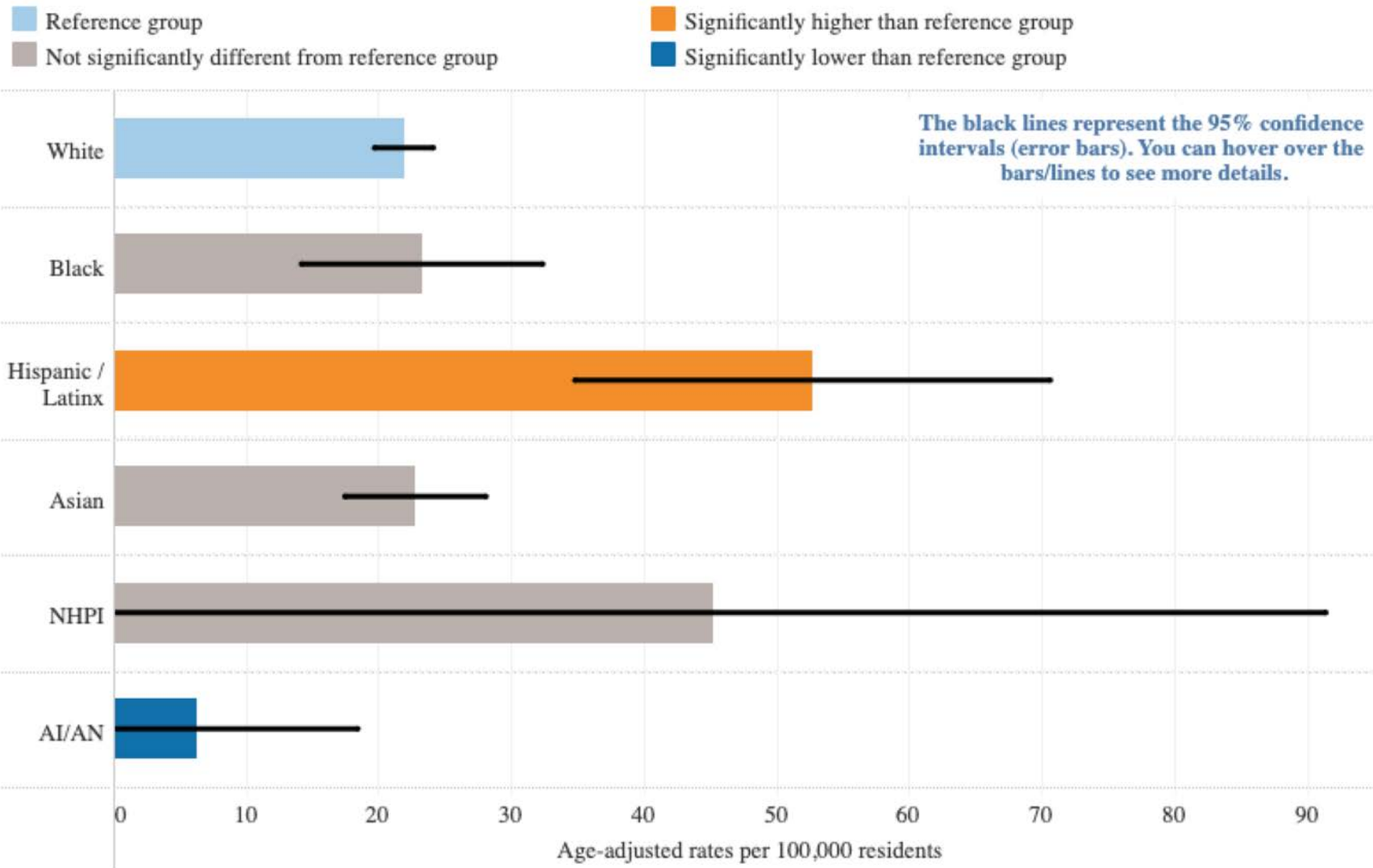
Age-adjusted rates per 100,000 residents

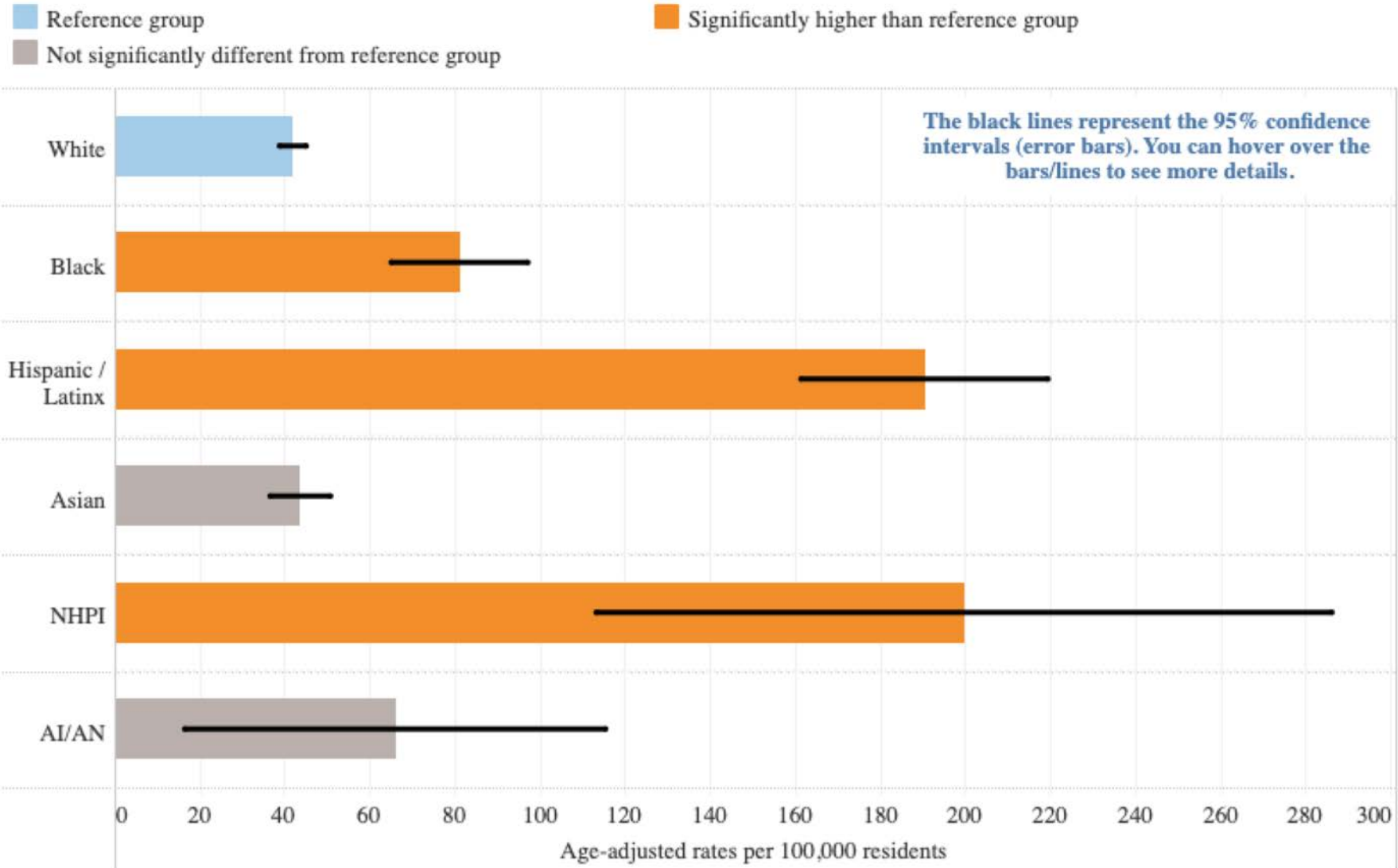
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Age-adjusted rates per 100,000 residents
